Stardust Pillar

Objective:

The objective of the Stardust Pillar is to encourage all of its members to partake in teamwork-oriented tasks. It is also our goal to become great exemplary leaders, innovators and active Terraria and TCT community members. We wish to do all of this while having as much fun as possible, while also participating in PvP roleplay alongside other players inside and outside of the Stardust Pillar, within the server.

Ranks:

Recruit

- New members receive this role upon joining, there are no prerequisites.
- Responsibilities include:
 - Any tasks given by higher ranks
 - Being generally active on the server.

Sergeant

- Obtained by outstanding activity, and demonstrating leadership and/or moderative qualities.
- Responsibilities include:
 - Moderation of all Recruits
 - Overseeing task progress on an individual level and helping out wherever necessary.
 - Leading teams of Recruits when requested to.
 - Answering any questions Recruits may have about the Pillar, tasks, or the server itself (Questions that cannot be answered straight away can be given to higher ranks or Staff).
 - Attending regular meetings (can be excused).

Stardust Pillar

Lieutenant

- Obtained by outstanding activity as a Sergeant, with a consistent display of good leadership and moderation.
- Responsibilities include:
 - Moderation of Sergeants and Recruits.
 - Overseeing task progress and allocating work to individual members. If any member cannot perform a task then the task can be assigned to another member more suited to such tasks.
 - Ensuring orders from Sergeants and any ranks with authority are followed. They can give their own orders if/when necessary.
 - Attending regular and emergency meetings if possible (can be excused if needed).
 - Headhunting potential members to join the Pillar, with desirable qualities and skills.

Stardust Pillar

Commander (Celestial Leader)

- Obtained by showing outstanding leadership and moderation qualities; Also shows very consistent activity.
- Responsibilities include:
 - Moderating all Pillar members equally and ensuring all tasks are worked on.
 - Hosting regular and emergency meetings.
 - Passing on tasks and orders from Staff and TCT Leaders.
 - Giving out tasks to all members when necessary.
 - Recruiting new members and giving necessary ranks.
 - Regular activity on the server and playing alongside all ranks - especially Recruits. This is to ensure some connection with new members, so they feel more open to discuss tasks, servers, and other issues.

Rules and Regulations

Rules and Regulations:

- Follow Terraria and Discord TOS
- Follow all TCT and Official Terraria server rules
- Do not use any form of offensive, bigoted, or highly disrespectful speech, harmful propaganda or misinformation.
- Report any bullying, abuse, cheating or other offenses to Staff and any high ranks in your Pillar.
- Follow any and all orders given by superior ranks. You can excuse yourself for a given amount of time at any point if you are unable to be active for a while. This ensures you will not lose your current roles.
- Do not falsely accuse anyone of breaching rules or spread rumours about players in any way.

Pledge Phase:

During this phase, any player willing to join this Pillar should submit a request to Mod Mail. They should also ask the Pillar Commanders any questions they might have in order to understand the server better when they first join.

Consequences & Misc.

Consequences of breaching any rules or inactivity include (but may not be limited to):

- Temporary suspension from any Pillar activity
- Temporary or permanent Pillar ban

Miscellaneous:

- **Meetings:**
 - Weekly meetings for all members on Sunday 12:00PM PST - 12:30PM PST
 - Sergeant, Lieutenant and Commander meeting Sunday 12:30PM PST - 1:15PM PST

Stardust Lore

As a star's journey ends, it is evident its legacy carries on. From the remaining dust many things can be formed; living beings, and materials from which weaponry, tools and armour can be made, among other things. The creatures formed by the influence of the Pillar, serve to protect the legacies of any and every star. It grows its forces in order to ensure such protection so that these legacies survive for the next generation of stars.

These same creatures also carry their role as the final guardians of the world from the Celestial Tyrant himself - the Moon Lord. They guard the world, alongside the forces of Solar, Vortex and Nebula Pillars, from its domination and possible intentions of destruction. The creatures held the interest, of not just protecting themselves, but all life forms on any given world at heart. They fought to protect the hope and safety of every world in order to preserve them.

As a result, should they learn of the death of any Cultist Leader, they will attempt to defeat the ones responsible for their demise, no matter the cost to their forces.

The **Stargazer** is a humanoid Stardust being who concentrates their energy into a deadly beam as their main means of attack, with some close-quarters ability akin to an average human, albeit far more powerful.

Stardust Lore

Outside of combat, they keep a close eye on the stars in the sky. They possess extremely extensive knowledge about astrology, being able to tell which stars are close to death and which are newborn just from a glance with their uniquely resilient eye. They are thought to possess an average human's intellect, and an extremely stellar ability to concentrate on tasks or their power.

Stargazers are also thought to be dreamers who hope for the safety of the stars' collective legacies and contemplate what will become of each star sooner or later.

The **Milkyway Weaver** is a cosmic worm-like creature that flies through the air with ease, weaving past attacks and through their enemies with great speed and agility.

Outside of combat, they like to weave beautiful line art resembling simple pictures, patterns or even mandalas using trails of stardust they drag through the air, for their Stardust brethren to gaze at in awe of their collective talents. They are thought to do this in order to practice flying elegantly through the air, or, far less interestingly, to show off their superior agility to their brethren fueling their pride as a Weaver.

Stardust Lore

The **Twinkle Popper** is a strange ground-based creature mostly resembling a mix of a horse's or antlion's maw and a large crab. They possess a very strong bite and the ability to vomit **Twinkles**, a lesser brethren produced inside their bodies. Twinkles have the ability to explode into a shower of scorching hot stardust akin to a fireworks' fiery display.

Outside of combat they are presumed to produce Twinkles on a large scale given how many they can vomit in battle. They are not known to have any intellect besides the ability to navigate even the toughest terrain in an extremely efficient manner. They are even able to adapt to changes in terrain, as a result of Ice Rod construction or explosions, almost instantly.

Star Cells are unique macro-organisms that resemble a cross between balls of plasma and severely magnified cells found in animals. They possess the ability to split into several copies of itself upon taking enough damage and grow each of those copies to the Cell's former size. They also have the ability to repeat this process an indefinite number of times. They attack by chasing a target in order to infect them; usually finding the closest potential host nearby. The infection is known as the most beautiful cellular mitosis in the known universe, but also known to be extremely painful for its host.

As such simple beings, they possess no intellect whatsoever.

Stardust Lore

The **Flow Invader** is a squid-like creature that flies through the air at a fairly swift speed. It is able to use its tentacles to strangle, whip or grab targets to bite into them, however its most prominent method of attack is by guiding lesser Invaders to their target while they rapidly accelerate to high velocities, like a bullet struck by a hammer.

Outside of combat Flow Invaders are known to play with their lesser brethren by spinning them around and releasing them to fly towards other Flow Invaders to repeat this process; similar to humans throwing frisbees at each other across a field. Given the great size of their brains and accuracy in guiding lesser Invaders, sometimes the creatures can predict where an enemy might go. They are presumed to possess great intellect and the ability to accurately calculate physics almost subconsciously.

The **Stardust Pillar** itself is the source of the Stardust creature's power and a gate for other beings to emerge from in case of an attack. It also serves as a prison for the tyrannical Moon Lord, keeping him far away from their world with the help of the other Pillars. It possesses a force field that can be broken by killing its guardians, a consequence of sharing its immense power with them.

Stardust Lore

The **Stardust Dragon** is a unique creature, boasting beautiful, shining golden armour on its semi-transparent, wyvern-like body. Its aggressive nature and tendency to target everything nearby, including Stardust creatures, was a good reason to seal it away from the world. Only a wielder of a *certain staff infused with the power of Stardust* could free the beast from its seal and control it, should they be found worthy.

The **Stardust Armour** can only be crafted and worn by a being deemed worthy and powerful enough; such as a being who could defeat the Moon Lord and save the world from his tyranny and wrath.

Such a creature would immediately be deemed worthy to possess the power of the **Stardust Guardian**, a powerful ghost-like entity that would act alongside the wearer of the Armour according to their will, by rapidly punching anything that would approach the wearer, pummeling even the toughest threats continuously until they died.

Stardust Lore

Creepium:

Very little can be said about this being, as it was only seen a handful of times exploring the darkest reaches of the universe in the unknown. What little is told of him through the tales of travellers and old men has yet to be pieced together in a manner that would reveal what he truly is. According to some stories, he is a flying squid-like creature with strong power. However, it is universally agreed upon that he pursues his own unique interest of exploring the uncharted.

A Stardust Guardian who thinks he does a lot of good things for his people, but is heavily flawed. He is ignorant to ideas, doesn't listen when he should, and is a meticulous perfectionist. He has gone so far as to disregard other ideas to realise his own vision of concepts. However, his intentions are fairly pure, wanting to help whenever he can, however he can, and improving himself at an admittedly slow pace.

There are not many known writings about Horti, in fact, his very existence itself might be a myth. Stars have a long life, but all end in an explosion, scattering hundreds of thousands of stardust fragments everywhere. At the edge of a recently deceased supermassive star, stardust accumulated and gave birth to a legend - a Flow Invader gifted with Stardust Wings and void powers, with only one known desire - idealism.

Horti wandered for quite some time and found similar, legendary beings of his kind. He gathered experience over the years and trained with those who later became great warriors, and dreaded enemies. His first accomplishments in the cosmos gave him a great reputation, and he was soon assigned to the prestigious guard of the Stardust Pillar. A new life began.

Stardust f.a.q.

I just joined the Pillar, what is the best way I can get started with the PVP?

Simply play on the server with the other members and obtain some nice gear. If you can enter a call with other members on the server (though this is not required), then you can easily grind for better equipment and discuss everything in general, and perhaps make a new friend or two.

I want to help with any tasks the Pillar members are given, what is the best way to ask if any tasks are available?

Ask any higher ranks through Discord DMs, general chat, or look at the pillar channels in the TCT server.

I want to take a break from the Pillar tasks, but I do not want to lose my roles. What can I do?

Send a message to Mod Mail asking to be excused and how long it will be. You may be excused as a result, and won't lose your roles for the time you take on break.

What should I do if there are no tasks available?

Have fun! Play with the other members and enjoy yourselves to the fullest, as you never know when unexpected tasks may appear.

Stardust f.a.q.

A given task is giving me a lot of stress, what should I do?

Discuss it with the other members, preferably a higher rank. If the task is extremely stressful, we will consider giving you a less stressful task instead, or ask you to help with one in progress as we ask another member to carry out the stressful task.

A higher rank is abusing their authority, who do I talk to?

Should this occur and you have some proof of it, contact Staff on the server and a Commander. We take abuse issues seriously, but keep in mind a fraudulent report can result in serious consequences.

How do I get promoted to a higher rank?

By following all rules, showing regular activity, showing interest in tasks, and showing qualities such as good leadership, helping someone stressed, and staying calm in any sort of panicked situation. Promotion to a Lieutenant or a Commander also requires time, commitment, and ultimately good patience. In order to be eligible for a promotion, you must first take and pass the leadership class.
